BackupEDGE 02.02.00b2

BackupEDGE 2.2 build 2 has begun shipping. There are a few minor changes, mostly supporting new operating system distributions.

UNIX Changes

All users of **SCO OpenServer 6** who install Maintenance Pack 3 (MP3) **must update** to 02.02.00 build 2. It contains a **RecoverEDGE** fix necessitated by the updated kernel.

Linux Changes

Most of the Linux changes are **RecoverEDGE** related and support newer Linux products. Specifically, openSUSE 10.3 and Ubuntu 7.10 (Gutsy Gibbon) are supported, along with additional UUID support for other distributions.

Java Updated

The Java themes and Web Services html wrappers and themes have been updated. Some of the fancier graphics have been removed to improve display performance and make the interfaces look more like the character interface.

Miscellaneous Changes

- DVD Writers with DVD-RAM support no longer perform multiple device ejects.
- Users running under "su" instead of "su -" will get proper path-name support.
- The SSL libraries have been updated for Web Services.

Who Should Update?

If you are running a **BackupEDGE** 2.x release and are utilizing FTP backups, are running SCO OpenServer 6 with MP3 or any of the newer Linux platforms, you should update to **02.02.00** during your next scheduled maintenance cycle. If you have tried **BackupEDGE** on a platform and it

has failed to function properly, you should try again with this release.

Update / Upgrade Policies

All users of **BackupEDGE** 02.00.01 (which started shipping on August 15, 2003) or later may download and install this release as a free update, provided it is on the same platform.

In-stock unregistered 2.x licenses will still work. There is no need to exchange or rotate them.

Users of legacy 01.0x releases may purchase an inexpensive upgrade from their favorite channel partner.
